



Information clause

According to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (OJ EU L 119 of 04.05.2016), I hereby inform that:

1. The Controller, within the meaning of Article 7(4) of the Polish Personal Data Protection Act of 29 August 1997 (Journal of Laws of 2014 item 1182), of the data contained in this statement is Torex sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Janowice, at the address: Janowice 1B, 99-120 Piątek.
2. The collected data will be processed by the Controller for the following purposes:
 - a) the provision of a service as part of conducted business activities based on the consent given by the customer or their processing is necessary for the performance of a sales contract and in order to take steps prior to entering into a contract (Article 6 (1)(a) and Article 6(1)(b) of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016)
 - b) marketing purposes under Article 6 (1)(a) and Article 6(1)(b) of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016, your personal data will be retained until your consent is withdrawn.
3. Personal data will be retained for the duration of the service or for a longer period if it is legally justified.
4. Personal data are not transferred outside Poland.
5. Personal data are not subject to profiling.
6. Providing personal data is voluntary, however, it is necessary to ensure the smooth circulation of information and the performance of the terms and conditions of the agreement between the parties.
7. You have the right to access, rectify and delete your data and to object to their processing. Objecting to data processing is tantamount to discontinuation of the performance of the terms and conditions of the agreement between the parties.
8. You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of data at any time.
9. You have the right to be forgotten and to transfer your data.
10. You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in the case of the violation of the conditions referred to in item 3 and 4 or when the processing violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016.
